

State Board Nominations for At-Large Members

We need nominations for two State Board At-Large Member positions that are opening up, this year. The following is a brief description of the positions.

Responsibilities

- Call in to teleconference meetings and show up to in-person board meetings (quarterly). Meetings are once a month.
- Be willing to listen and learn. You'll be amazed at the ideas you may come up with once you get your feet wet.
- Be willing to do what you can; for example, writing a proposal, revamping the BRB, or helping to plan new policies. You decide.
- Know how to say "yay" or "nay."

Attendance Policy

- Must attend at least one of the four in-person state board meetings; there is a state board meeting at the annual meeting.
- Cannot miss more than two consecutive state board meetings; a chapter designee may attend in place without voting privilege.
- The balance of state board meetings are conducted via teleconference. Meeting days are progressive Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday.

Nominations Are Being Accepted until January 7

Nominations for two (2) State Board At-Large Members are now being accepted. These are two-year terms. You must be an MMBA member to sit on the board. You can request to be placed on the ballot by submitting a "Bio" with the following information to the nomination committee at simse@ntcna.nissan-usa.com:

- Applicants history and accomplishments with the MMBA.
- What the applicant would like the MMBA to achieve in the following year and how the applicant will help the MMBA to achieve that goal.

- Other MMBA members who are familiar with the applicants work, preferably a chapter officer or trail coordinator.
- Any active and respected candidates will then be placed on the ballot and the bios will be placed on the MMBA website. Any questions should be directed to simse@ntcna.nissan-usa.com.
